

Chapter 73

Elections

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Cleveland at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. II). Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 73-1 Registration of electors.

Pursuant to the provisions of § 6.28, Wis. Stats., it is hereby authorized and required that electors in the Town are registered for all elections in the Town.

§ 73-2 Poll hours.

All election polls in the Town shall be opened at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. for all elections, primaries, and referendums.

§ 73-3 Election officials.

- A. The Town of Cleveland shall allow for the selection of two or more sets of election officials to work at different times on election day and permit the Town Clerk or the Clerk's designee to establish different working hours for different officials assigned at the same polling place.
- B. Pursuant to 7.32, Wis. Stats., the minimum number of election officials required to work at the polling place during a Town election is three. However, the Town Clerk may assign additional poll workers if he/she believes they are needed for a given election. The number of poll workers assigned shall always be an odd number.
