1. Chairman Jochimsen called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

4. Balsam Road – There have been discussions about the condition of the road and the extensive cost of black top. Jerry Fahrner had been requested to discuss this road by the highway committee members.
- a. Jerry Fahrner – recommended double chip seal
 - i. Wide Road – recommend grass to grass
 - ii. More flexible treatment than black top
 - iii. Life expectancy – 8-10 years (no maintenance during this time except possible crack seal as needed). No grading needed.
 - b. Jim Griesbach, Highway Commissioner, Marathon County Highway Department
 - i. TRIP money – eligible as the TOC has only taken the TRIP money one time. This has to be approved by the Marathon County Highway Commissioner. Jim stated that he would not approve
 - ii. We would be eligible for a project for 2022-2023. The range is \$26K - \$28K. Double chip seal on paved road would qualify. They would also approve base coat for Balsam when paving is going to be done within a few years. Structures are eligible but no one has ever applied. Program starts in September 2021.
5. Edgewater Road
- a. Double chip seal
 - b. \$55K per mile for cold in place recycling
6. Road counters
- a. Balsam Road (west of The Shack) – average daily traffic 385
 - b. Big Rapids Road – average daily traffic 305
 - c. Rock Road – average daily traffic 170

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- d. Balsam Road (east of The Shack) – average daily traffic 170
- 7. Bridge Program – 2024 – 2027 or 2025 – 2029
 - a. 80 (Federal or State) /20 (Local with 50% split with County) on Construction and 100 on Design
 - b. The town has to fund the 20% and then get reimbursed by the county.
