\$40K	Maryel Subdivision - corner of Maryel and Elroy to boat landing, fix soft spots
\$40K	Wiesman Road – corner of Weisman Rd/Schnelle Rd .25 mile to the south soft spots

\$5K Schnelle Road – East of Weisman - .5 mile 80 foot segment

\$13K Big Rapids Road – Corner of Hwy M west 300-400 feet – 350 feet

2023

\$150-\$200K Soft Spots (hold on Balsam)

2024

\$150-\$200K Evaluate Balsam if it held up well; then complete the rest of Balsam Road through Spindler Bridge. If it does not hold up, then we do breaker rock/gravel lift and prepare for double chip seal.

2024-2025

\$80-\$100K 20% funding for Fairview Bridge (total cost \$500K)

Get costs for Balsam annually and what can be saved (labor for grading 1/week plus gravel)

\$150-200K The below roads are the priority to be chip sealed after Balsam
